

MEETING MINUTES

May 23, 2013

A meeting of the Blue Mountain (Kees) Cemetery Board was held in the basement of Memorial Hall in Weston. Present were directors Kathleen McCullough, Tim Adams, Vicki Bender, Bob Gilliland, and Don Lieuallen.

Copies of the minutes of the previous meeting were distributed. There is \$2157.37 in the bank account plus 2 undeposited checks for \$25 each. Total of the bank balance plus the undeposited checks is \$2207.31.

Statement was received for service work done on the lawnmower by Farm Equipment Headquarters. Work done included changing oil and oil filters, sharpening blades, belt inspection and lubrication. Bender moved, seconded by Adams, that the FEH bill for \$349.34 be paid. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Adams discussed a wish to saw off a locust tree limb protruding over the south fence. The consensus of the group was that the limb needed to be removed.

Also by consensus, it was determined to be the wish of the group that the padlock be taken off the gate on May 25 and not replaced until the end of the Pioneer Reunion weekend.

Sheldon Delph addressed the Board on the subject of grants that may be available. Those of particular interest are from the Wildhorse Foundation and the Oregon Commission on Historic Cemeteries. Delph felt that no grant funds would be available from AWERE for about 2 years due to their prioritization of funding a new track for Weston-McEwen High School. Tiah DeGrofft is the contact person for grant applications through the Wildhorse Foundation.
