Dot Supply Building & U.S. Post Office (Historic Site)
202-204 East Main Street, Weston, Oregon

202-204 East Main Street (SE corner of East Main Street & North Franklin St)

Common name: Dot Supply Building and U.S. Post Office

Date of construction: c. 1960

Significance: Intrusive, or non-historic



Description: Single story concrete block building, square in plan, measuring approximately 60 feet on a side. Set back from Main Street about 25 feet and surrounded on all sides by asphalt pavement. Easterly portion of building is leased to U.S. Postal Service as postal station. **This is the site of the historic Marshall House, Weston's finest hostelry, a**

two-story brick masonry building in the Italianate Style which was torn down in the Mid-1930s.
